Is a child in your life developing differently or having problems learning?

If so, help is available for eligible children in New Jersey.

For Preschool Children and Students (Three through Twenty-one)

If you are concerned your preschool child or student is developing or learning differently and you live in New Jersey, you can call your public school district to find out the appropriate contact person in your district.

How to Make a Referral

If you would like to request an evaluation for special education and related services, send a written request for an evaluation to your district. Include your child's name, age, address and suspected disability.

After receiving your written request, the district's child study team has twenty days to have a meeting with you the parent(s). At this meeting, you and the team will decide if an evaluation is needed and what the evaluation will include.

To the maximum extent appropriate preschoolers and students with disabilities receive their education with children who are not disabled.
