THERAPLAY

Theraplay is a therapeutic group for special needs children and their parents that utilizes therapeutic play and sensory activities to develop relationships and social/communication skills.

For children 2 to 5 years of age

During Theraplay:

- Children and their parents engage in structured activities together to promote bonding and build attachment relationships for 45 minutes.
- ❖ Parents will then meet in a separate area for parent support, in which discussions, articles and activities will focus on parenting skills, child development topics and family life.
- Children will be led in structured activities that promote social interaction, rule compliance and cooperative play.
- Activities will focus on sensory play, which encourages a variety of skills including fine and gross motor skills, self-esteem, creativity, and cognitive skills.

The Theraplay group is held on a weekday morning for a ten week duration for a fee of \$275.00

There will be a maximum of eight children per group
