

PUBLIC NOTICE - REVISION TO ANNUAL MEETING SCHEDULE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Glen Rock Board of Education hereby amends its annual meeting notice to confirm that the public meetings scheduled for October 26, 2020, November 16, 2020, December 14, 2020, and January 4, 2021 shall be *both* an in-person and remote meeting in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act and the emergency regulations set forth in N.J.A.C. 5:39-1.1 to -1.7. The meetings will begin at 7:00 p.m. with the Board recessing to closed session and then reopening to the public at approximately 8:00 p.m. and shall be held at the Glen Rock High School/Middle School cafeteria, located at 400 Hamilton Avenue, Glen Rock, New Jersey 07452. Action will be taken at these meetings.

Due to capacity restrictions imposed by Governor Murphy's Executive Orders, members of the public desiring to attend any meeting in person must email boardsecretary@glenrocknj.org seven days before the meeting but not later than noon on the day of the meeting to provide their name and their desire to attend. The Administrative Assistant to the Business Administrator/Board Secretary will place the names of all interested in attending the meeting and select names randomly. Members of the public will be notified by 3:00 p.m. only if their names were chosen in the lottery. Until the capacity restrictions of twenty-five people for an in-person gathering are lifted, no more than ten members of the public may attend a Board meeting in person due to the number of Board members, administrators, and staff present in the meeting room.

Members of the public may also attend the meetings remotely via Zoom. Due to the current capacity restrictions in place and the COVID-19 pandemic, the Board strongly encourages members of the public to attend meetings via Zoom. Individuals wishing to make public comment during any of the meetings may do so in the following ways: (1) in person, if they are able to attend in person; (2) via Zoom, for those using Zoom on an electronic device; (3) via telephone for those who dial into the Zoom meeting via telephone; or (4) through written submissions, which must be sent to boardsecretary@glenrocknj.org for email comments or to the Board Secretary for letters sent

via mail or hand delivery at 620 Harristown Road, Glen Rock, New Jersey. Written comments must be received no later than noon on the day of the meeting.
